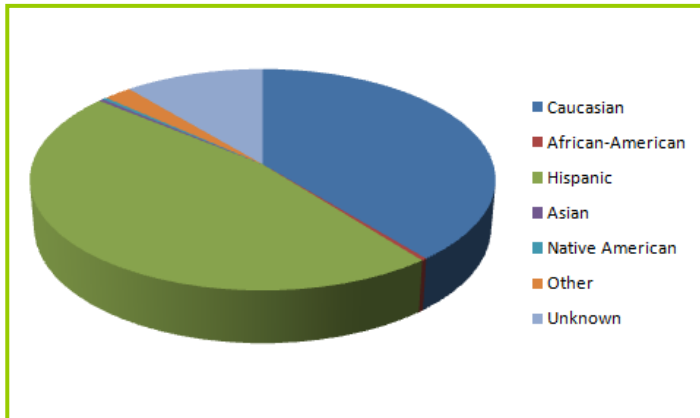
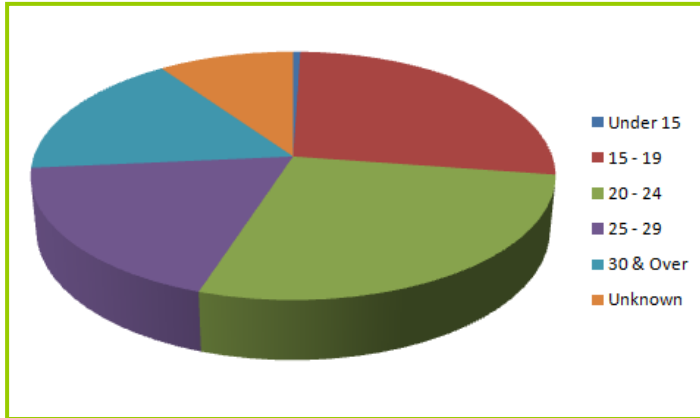
Just who are Pregnancy Center clients?
