Concerned parents should take note that there are certain little secrets nestled into the proposed National Health Care Plan that could alter their ability and even right to parent their children as they see fit.

Sections 440 and 1904 of the House bill (Page 838), under the heading "home visitation programs for families with young children and families expecting children" could lay the

groundwork for the State's usurping of parental authority over child care and development in our very homes. Congress's bill clearly states that the government agents, 'well-trained and competent staff,' would 'provide parents with knowledge of age-appropriate child development in cognitive, language, social, emotional, and motor domains ... modeling, consulting, and coaching on parenting practices. 'These government funded programs are overseen by the State, and will 'promote coordi-

God's Provision

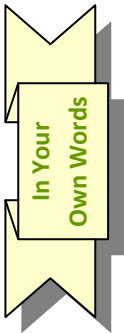
